








Curriculum Information - Year One and Two - Summer 1

<p>Class text</p>	<p>This half term we will be focusing on two texts. These are The tiger who came to tea by Judith Kerr and Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers.</p>	 
<p>RE</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will begin this half term by focusing on the unit Easter. This unit will develop the children's knowledge and understanding of the season of Easter as a celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus. The children will understand the importance of the Resurrection and its message. We will then move on to the unit of Pentecost. This will develop the children's understanding and knowledge of Pentecost as the fulfilment of Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit. The children will learn about the coming of the Holy Spirit as a promised gift that brought about a change in the lives of the disciples and how we celebrate and receive that gift in our lives today. 	 
<p>English</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The focus for this half term in Literacy is recounts and description. Some of the grammar focuses for Y1 will be: the use of plurals, using capital letters and full stops correctly and consistently - specifically for names of places and people, writing sentences dictated by the teacher, using appropriate adjectives to add extra information, using questions within writing and using the 	

	<p>prefix 'un' e.g. unkind, unhappy, untrue.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Some of the reading objectives that Y1 will focus on are asking and answering questions about the text and inferring how characters are feeling and what they are thinking using both pictures and text. • Some of the grammar focuses for Y2 will be: the use of plurals, the appropriate and correct use of commas, nouns, expanded noun phrases and synonyms, sentence types and using alternative sentence openers. • Some of the reading objectives that Y2 will be focusing on: asking and answering questions about the text in full sentences and using text to infer characters thoughts and feelings to a sophisticated level.
<p>Maths</p> 	<p><u>Y1</u></p> <p>Unit 11: Multiplication and Division</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Count in 2s, 5s and 10s. - Make and add equal groups. - Make arrays. - Make doubles. <p>Unit 12: Fractions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Find half of a shape or quantity. - Share equally. - Find a quarter of a shape or quantity. <p>Unit 13: Position and direction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Describe turns. - Use the words left and right. - Say if something is above or below something else. - Say if something is moving forwards or backwards. <p><u>Y2:</u></p> <p>Unit 10: Fractions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn about the whole and equal parts. - Recognise and find a half. - Recognise and find a quarter. - Learn about unit and non-unit fractions. - Learn about equivalent halves and quarters. <p>Unit 11: Time</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tell time to the hour and half hour. - Tell the time to quarter to and quarter past. - Tell the time to 5 minutes. - Learn about minutes and hours. <p>Unit 12: Problem solving and efficient methods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Compare ways of calculating. - Use mental addition and subtraction. - Look for the most efficient way to solve a problem. - Use number facts to solve problems. - Solve word problems using all four operations.

Science



This half term we will be returning to our unit '**Animals including humans.**' This half term, we will be focusing on function, change and growth within animals. The children will be able to:

- Know that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- Know what animals and humans need to survive.
- Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.



Geography



This half term in Geography we will be looking at **foods from around the world.** The children will be able to:

- Know the Names of and locate the seven continents of the world.
- Know the names of and locate the five oceans of the world.
- Know how jobs may be different in other locations.



DT



This half term our big question is '**What will I serve with my Greek salad?**' The children will be planning and making their own dish to serve alongside their very own Greek salad.

The children will be able to:

- Describe the ingredients used when making a dish or a cake.
- Explain what went well with their work.
- Weigh ingredients to use in a recipe.
