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


Mary Mother of God







- This week we are going to think about the role that Mary was selected for by God.

- Task 2 - Read the Bible passages provided and answer the questions posed.






<p>Science</p> 	<p>Evolution and Inheritance- Theory of Evolution</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we are going to learn more about Darwin's theory of evolution - how he came to his theory and look at two other examples of evolution in animals (mice and giraffes) Complete the lesson including the quiz at the end on the National Oak Academy - following this link https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/what-is-the-theory-of-evolution Follow-up task: Choose two animals to complete animal adaptation cards for. You can choose from the animals provided or select two of your own. You will need to research the answers online. 	
<p>Geography</p> 	<p>Maps - Planning a Route</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we are going to plan a journey using the eight compass points and four or six-figure grid references that we have been learning about Work your way through the Planning a Route presentation completing the mini-tasks along the way Main task- Plan a journey as described in the 	

	presentation and on the activity sheet. Once you've written your instructions, get a parent or sibling to try and follow them!	
Art 	Still Life <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This week we will continue to build up the skills in order to draw our own still life composition particularly focusing on tone. Look at the Tonal Shading presentation. Task: Complete the tonal shading activity sheets. Start thinking about your composition for next week- what objects will you select?
