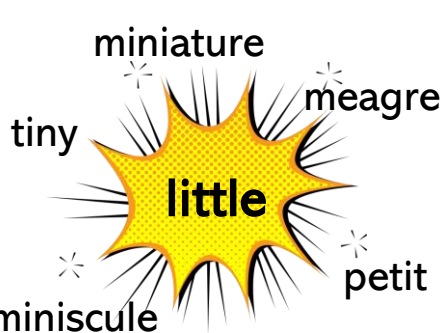


TASK 1... SYNONYMS

Each synonym explosion contains an adjective from the video clip. Can you think of as many *synonyms* as you can for each word?

You can use a thesaurus to help you.



TASK 2... ANTONYMS



In the boxes, write an *antonym* of the word in bold.

Remember:

- read the *whole* sentence first
- Antonyms have the opposite meaning

Trunchball was a **terrible** teacher.

With a **smile**, Matilda walked away.

Cramped, the newt **wiggled** in the glass.

Veruca Salt was stupendously **wealthy**.

TASK 3... APPLY IT!

- 1) Write three '*the more, the more*' sentences based on the video. (see example below)
- 2) Next, highlight an adjective or verb in your sentence.
- 3) Then, write a *synonym* of the word above it.



EXAMPLE:

babbled
