Dancing flames came down and touched the disciples on the head, they knew that this was the Holy Spirit.



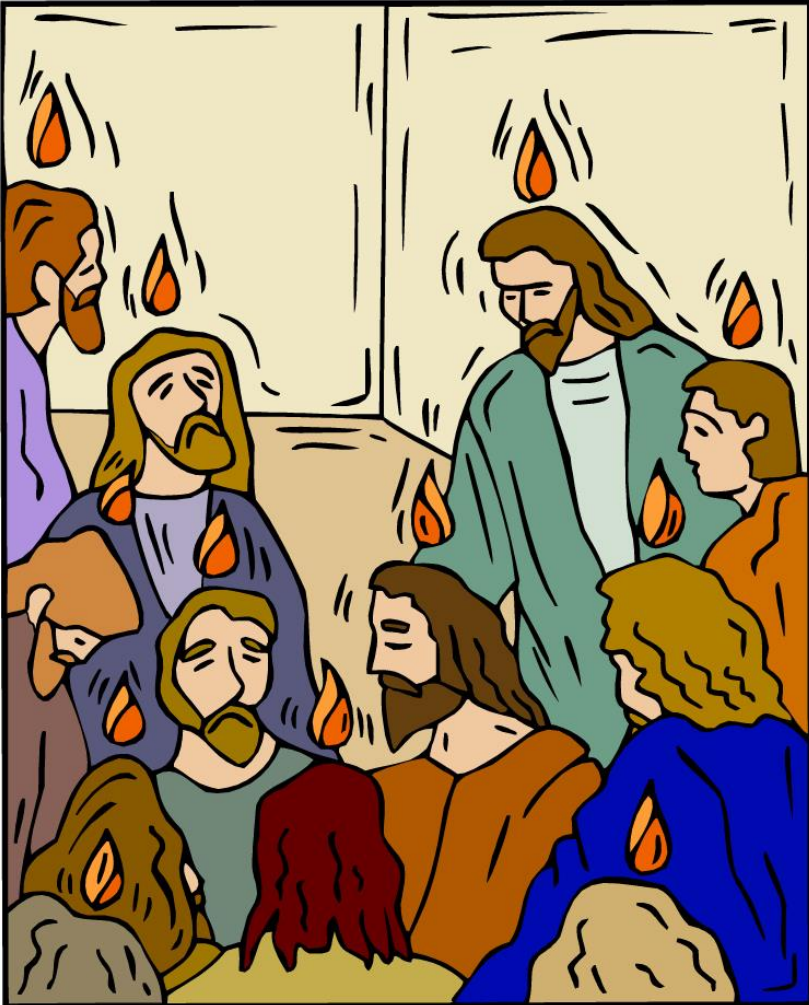
The disciples found that they could speak in every language. They went out into the street and told the world the Good News.

The Holy Spirit does not help us to speak in different languages. He brings us fruits that grow inside us to help us to live our lives more like Jesus.

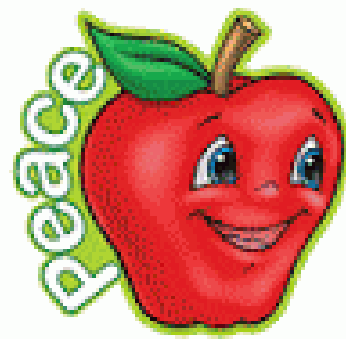
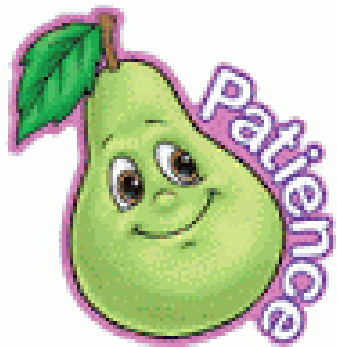
We can do the same job as the disciples did in spreading the good news, by making sure we use the fruits that the spirit has given us in our every day lives.
