Dear Parents,

Firstly a little note to say thank you for your continued support with your child's learning and development. We want to give as much support as we can with your child's reading and phonics during this time. Therefore we have updated your child's reading book and word purse to ensure that you have the resources to practise your child's reading and extend their phonics knowledge.

## For Reception parents -

We have put in your child's diary a new **reading** book that is working within their phonic knowledge

We have added all **phase 2 phoneme flashcards and phase 3** (where applicable)

All High Frequency words

We have also put into your child's words purse a CVC sentence matching game

Please take your time when going through these new sounds introduce 2 new ones a week so that the phoneme can be practised correctly. Below is a link to the **Jolly Phonics** songs on youtube so that you can see how each phoneme should be pronounced.
