Manor Adventure Le Chateau De Warsy, Picardy, Northern France

Location

- Le Château de Warsy, part of the Manor Adventure Group and is not open to the general public
- Located at the focal point of a small hamlet in Picardy
- The centre is just a 2 hour drive from Calais.
- Many of the popular visits are within easy reach.

Accommodation

Within the Château grounds schools are accommodated in an exclusive village of four bedded pods with their own shower and toilet block and dining facilities. Luxury Camping at the Château is a new concept of wooden pods, which are a cross between traditional canvas tents and wooden chalets. Each pod has electric lighting and heating and built-in bunks.

Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC)

- Your GHIC lets you get state healthcare at a reduced cost or sometimes for free. It will cover you for treatment that is needed to allow you to continue your stay until your planned return.
- Every child will need a card which will be carried by Mrs Statham whilst in France.

Passports

- If your child has a passport, they will be required to use this.
- If your child does not have a passport and are British National, can travel on a collective passport

Collective Passports

- A form is required to be filled out by a parent of every child.
- Please check criteria carefully and check which parent is required to sign the form.
- The school also completes a form naming every child, their town and country of birth, along with their date of birth.
- Each child will be issued with a photo card which will be signed by the child and the group leader (Mrs Statham).
- Children DO NOT need a passport in order to go

Cost & Reminders

- The cost of the trip will be £550
- Initial (non refundable) deposit £50 due by Monday 1st July
- Monday 15th July Confirmation slip returned to school
- Second (non refundable) deposit £50 due by Friday 13th September
- The balance of £450 can then either be paid;
 In full via Scopay by Friday 27th September 2024, or...

Cost & Reminders

- 9 monthly payments by standing order:
- Payments will begin on Tuesday 1st October 2024
- Last payment will be Monday 2nd June 2025
- This will comprise of x9 monthly payments of £50
- If you choose the standing order option you must complete a standing order form and return it to the office no later than Friday 19th July 2024
- Children will need additional spending money (English and Euros)
