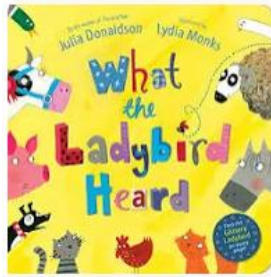

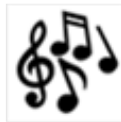
## Maths
