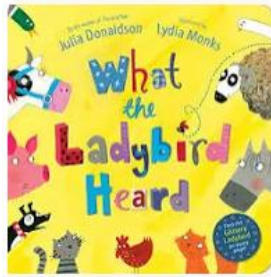
Week Beginning: 20th April

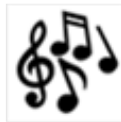
Maths

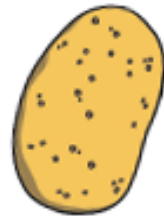
- In Phonics...
