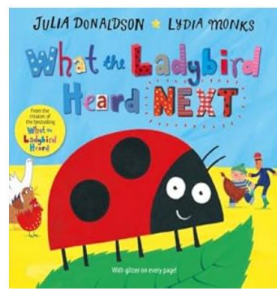
Week Beginning: 5th May

This week the children will...

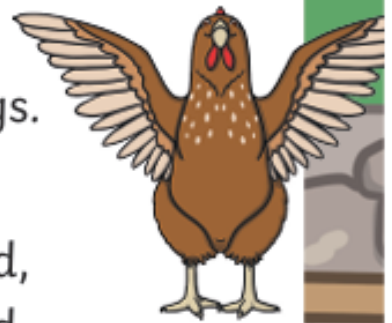
- In Phonics...
