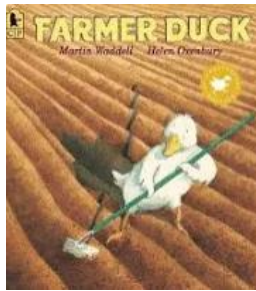
Week Beginning: 11th May

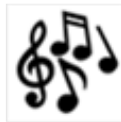
Maths
