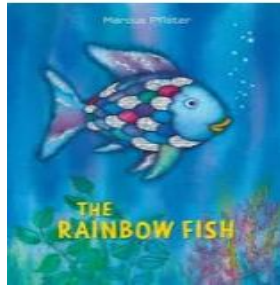
Week Beginning: 8th June

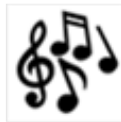
Maths
