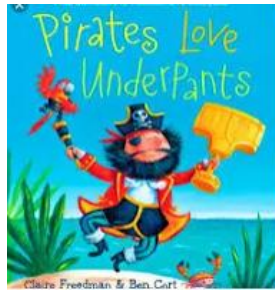
Week Beginning: 29th June
