Relationships and Health Education Policy

As a Catholic school, our mission is to support the spiritual, moral, social and cultural development of all our pupils, rooted in the wisdom and teaching of the Church. The education of children in human sexuality is an important, precious and privileged responsibility. The Church teaches us that this is very much a partnership with parents, in which parents are the 'first educators' of their children on these matters; ultimately, you confer on us the right to co-educate your children with you.

The school adopts the programme '**Life to the Full**' by Ten:Ten Resources. Ten:Ten is an award-winning Catholic educational organisation that is well-respected and very experienced in this field of work. Life to the Full has been approved by our diocese. Furthermore, Ten:Ten have entered a partnership with the Catholic Education Service and the Department for Education to provide training for teachers in Catholic schools.

Through their programme, Ten:Ten understands the foundational role that parents have in educating and nurturing their children on these matters. Within the programme, they have built in resources which will not only keep you informed about what is being taught in school but will also give you the opportunity to engage your children in discussion, activity and prayer.

The RSHE policy can be found on the school's website. In the policy you will find the section about the four key decisions and what has been decided for each one and why.

Relationships and Health Education (including the biological aspect of science) is statutory in a primary school and must be taught. However, parents do have a right to withdraw their child from the specific sex education lessons. These can be seen on the online parent portal (see the log in below). If you want to withdraw your child from any sex education lesson, please see the request for withdrawal from at the end of the policy.

Teaching of RSHE using the Ten:Ten scheme happens throughout the school year. The Ten:Ten **Online Parent Portal** is a tool you can use throughout the year to keep you informed and updated about the work we are doing in school. It provides parents with:

- Information about the programme children will be following
- Access to resources
- Suggestions for further activity at home
