Monday Morning

- Please arrive at school at the usual time.
- Suitcases/Holdalls/Rucksacks can be taken into the school hall.
- **Any medication must be handed to Mrs Catalano– and included on the medical form.**
- What you bring you will carry – please avoid bringing too large a case/holdall. Bedding is not needed.
- The school mini-buses will take the children to Stanley Head

Friday Afternoon

- Children will return to school during the afternoon.
- Parents may collect children from school on return at approx. 2.15 – 2.30pm.

Snacks

- * Children only need to take one packet of biscuits.
- These are collected in and shared out during supper time
- No other drinks or snacks should be taken
- * However, as a school, we provide a tuck shop – with cartons of juice, crisps and sweets.
- * The children can take money to spend at the tuck shop. However, they will only need a maximum of £1 per evening.
- * There is no shop at Stanley Head to buy souvenirs.

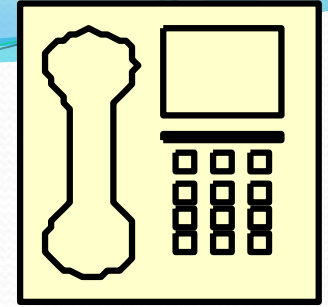
Forms to be signed

- School Consent Form.
- Stanley Head Parental Consent Form. *
- Medical Form (One week before we go)

* If these forms are not completed, then the children can not take part in the activities.

A kit list is provided as a guide.

Contact



- Children can NOT take mobile phones.
- Parents will only be contacted should a problem arise. However, general texts/Facebook posts will be sent out to let you know how the children are getting on.
- If a parent needs to contact their child they must do this by contacting Mrs Rathbone at the school or via email out of school hours.

Equipment

- You will be given a kit list with the types of clothing needed – please label where possible.
- All bedding is provided – the children don't need to take any.
- You must take a mug (hot chocolate in the evening)
- You should take a torch.
- Girls – no straighteners! Hairdryers allowed – ideally share.
- No Iphones/Ipads or any other electrical devices.

Equipment

- Teddies are allowed!
- Small games, books, cards, wordsearches, notepads are ideal.
- Try not to take too much – and encourage your son/daughter to keep their belongings safe and organised.



Sleeping Arrangements

We will be sleeping in Dorms.

Boys and girls are in separate buildings.

Members of staff will sleep in each building in separate staff rooms.

Food

- The food at Stanley Head is varied, nutritious and healthy.
- Any dietary needs will be catered for.
- The children choose their meals the day before (tick their choices) and there is a huge selection. All tastes are catered for!



Supervision

As well as Stanley Head staff the children will always be supervised by members of Staff from St. Mary's or Our Lady of Grace.

In Loco Parentis



This means that the trip leader assumes the role of the parent for the week.

It is my responsibility to act as a responsible parent for the week.

If there was a need to contact parents, I would not hesitate to do so.

Medical Needs

- You will be given a medical questionnaire to fill in closer to departure (1 week before) No Slip...No Trip!
- Children must NOT carry their own medication. This MUST be given to Mrs Catalano on the Monday morning (Please check age limits, best before dates etc.)
- Children must carry their own blue inhalers.
- If there is anything else we need to know, please see me after the meeting or before the trip. (This will be treated with the strictest confidence.)

Behaviour

Although Stanley Head have their rules, OLOG expects the highest standards of behaviour. Should your child not behave to these standards, you will be asked to collect your child and then they will attend school as normal. Should Stanley Head choose to send your child home, the same rules apply. We want all children to enjoy themselves. In order for this to happen, all must behave.
