but

is used when we are contrasting things.
in our writing.

but

is used when we are writing about alternatives.

It was very cold in the morning. The ground was frozen.

It was very cold in the morning and the ground was frozen.

It was my bed time. I wasn't tired.

It was my bed time but I wasn't tired.

Would you like some juice? Would you like some water?

Would you like some juice or would you like some water?
