When we use a conjunction e.g. and, both clauses are as important as each other. The monster road loudly and he chased the little girl. Sometimes we want to add more information to our sentences. This information is extra and not as important as our main clause. When we want to do this, we use a

subordinating conjunction.

There are lots of subordinating conjunctions but we are going to look more closely at these four:
















The subordinating conjunction doesn't always have to be in the middle of the sentence. It can also be used at the beginning.




