

You may notice that instead of illustrations, there are non-fiction (real life/factual) Can you discuss what things we find in a nonfiction book compared to a fiction book? (Photographs instead of illustrations, headings on each page) Do these books still have a title? A front cover?

Please note - this is just a suggested timetable for your day. Please feel free to complete the learning when you feel is best.

English	Animal fact file! Choose an animal from our story or an animal of you own and write your own fact file. Think about - What animal it is? Where this animal lives? (habitat) What they like to eat? Do they change the way they live in the winter? If you are not so confident writing sentences, you can draw a picture of your chosen animal and tell your adult what facts you have learnt.
Maths	Number bonds! https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=y1oa6oOfMKk Practice your number bonds and see if an adult can test you on them! What numbers add together to make 3? What about 2? Maybe if you really wanted to challenge yourselves you could use a timer!

English	Artic adventure! Imagine we are taking a school trip to the Artic to see what animals we can find! What would you pack in your suitcase? You could draw a template like this one here Can you draw all of the things you would take? Challenge - write a list of the items so that you don't forget what to take with you! (woolly hat, gloves, scarf, boots, coats, binoculars, tent, packed lunch)	
Maths	Shape penguins! Can you use different shapes to make a penguin? Triangle for a beak? Circles for eyes? You can use crafts or draw your penguin with pencils

P.E	Try one of Mr Sigley's P.E challenges Can you do a forward roll? Or show different ways to balance?
Story time	Daily online session at 2:00pm
Wednesday	
English	Alliteration! Pick a phoneme, any phoneme and see what objects you can find around the house that begin with that phoneme. Example: s - sock, sugar, slippers t - table, tomato, tea cup Challenge - Make a list of all the things you find.
Maths - continue all half term!	Money- please practice recognising different coins with the children. You can do this by looking at different coins, sorting coins or using the Purple mash task set on the 2do (this is accessible all this half term) Please also practice making amounts, when the children are ready. For example, an apple is 4p. What coins can we use to make this amount? (2p + 2p, 1p + 1p + 1p + 1p, 2p + 1p + 1p)

EA&D	Can you build or create an igloo! You can use junk modelling or any construction you have at home! You could even draw and design one on paper or on 2simple 2 paint!

English/R.E	Baptism Were baptised as a baby or a little older? Try and discuss what happens at a Baptism. Baptism is a special occasions celebrated in a Catholic Church and for many families. Can you write an invitation to someone, inviting them to your baptism?
Maths	Subitising This is when children see an amount and automatically recognise how many there are without counting. For example when you roll a dice quite often the children can recognise how many dots there are without counting. Try this with different amounts. Maths	Problem solvers! Keep using practical and written methods to problem solve Count out different amounts (to 10), can you find one more one less? (you may or may not want to do this practically) Can you add amounts together or subtract amounts? Challenge! You could write the + and - sentences to go with your problems
