

Year 3 Summer spelling test 1: Teacher's script

This test should take approximately 15 minutes to complete. Tell the children you are going to read out 20 sentences to them. Each sentence has a word missing on their answer sheet. Tell the children to listen carefully to the missing word and fill it in, making sure they spell it correctly. You will read the word, then the word within a sentence, then repeat the word a third time. Now read out each question to the children as below. At the end of the test read out all 20 sentences again.

1 Spelling one: the word is **woman**.

The **woman** on the left is my aunt.

The word is **woman**.

2 Spelling two: the word is **remember**.

I can never **remember** jokes.

The word is **remember**.

3 Spelling three: the word is **prefer**.

Would you **prefer** an apple or an orange?

The word is **prefer**.

4 Spelling four: the word is **believe**.

Do you **believe** in ghosts?

The word is **believe**.

5 Spelling five: the word is **heard**.

I **heard** that there will be free pizza at lunchtime.

The word is **heard**.

6 Spelling six: the word is **bicycle**.

I'm getting a new **bicycle** for my birthday.

The word is **bicycle**.

7 Spelling seven: the word is **eight**.

Spiders have **eight** legs.

The word is **eight**.

8 Spelling eight: the word is **groan**.

There was a **groan** when the comedian told the same old joke again.

The word is **groan**.

9 Spelling nine: the word is **address**.

What is the school **address**?

The word is **address**.

10 Spelling ten: the word is **accident**.

Isaac broke the window by **accident**.

The word is **accident**.

11 Spelling eleven: the word is **opposite**.

I live **opposite** the park.

The word is **opposite**.

12 Spelling twelve: the word is **regular**.

It is important to have a **regular** check-up with your dentist.

The word is **regular**.

13 Spelling thirteen: the word is **calendar**.

Each year I buy a new **calendar** to put birthdays on.

The word is **calendar**.

14 Spelling fourteen: the word is **scene**.

My favourite **scene** in the film was when the animals started to speak.

The word is **scene**.

15 Spelling fifteen: the word is **enormous**.

What an **enormous** ice-cream!

The word is **enormous**.

16 Spelling sixteen: the word is **injection**.

Having an **injection** is not as bad as you think.

The word is **injection**.

17 Spelling seventeen: the word is **gardener**.

The park **gardener** does a wonderful job.

The word is **gardener**.

18 Spelling eighteen: the word is **trouble**.

I knew that dog would be **trouble**.

19 Spelling nineteen: the word is **pleasure**.

It is my **pleasure** to welcome you to this class.

20 Spelling twenty: the word is **disobey**.

Why did you **disobey** my instructions?
