<p>English</p> 	<p>HELP!!</p> <p>Boy and girls we need your help! We have discovered this morning that some sort of villain has broken into our classroom and held our school vegetables hostage!!!</p> <p>The broccoli is hanging upside down! The carrots are trapped in containers and cucumber is on the chopping board!! Who could have done this?!</p> <p>We need you to design a wanted poster to try and catch whichever villain has committed this crime! Some of the children think it might be Evil Pea! I think he might have a vegetable apprentice who is helping him!</p> <p>(Please see purple mash for Wanted poster template if you would like to use this)</p>  
<p>Math</p>	<p>Measure - Making prediction</p> <p>Ask your adult to choose 10 items around your house. Now before you compare them like last week's activities.</p> <p>I would like you to make some predictions! This is just like a guessing game!</p> <p>Ask your adult to pick 2 items at a time or 3 if you like the challenge.</p> <p>Can you predict which would be heavier and which would be lighter? Maybe the adults could make it abit harder for you and choose similar objects (such as a pear and an apple)</p> <p>Once you have made your prediction, test it out! Were you correct?</p> <p>You could share your findings on Evidence me!</p>
