<p>RE</p>	<p>To learn about the significance of the Last Supper. Read through the story of the Last Supper on the slides (taken from Mark 14:12-26). In the Gospel of John (13:1-17) it describes how Jesus washed his disciple's feet. This tells us that Jesus came to be a servant and that he was showing his disciples how to follow his example. Christians today still follow the example of the Last Supper and and share bread and wine in remembrance of Jesus' death. This is called the Eucharist. Use the information sheet to help you to answer the questions.</p>
